### Councillor's Foreword

AI THNÍTEAR GO BHFUL earnáil na n-ealaíon cruthaitheach ina hearnáil bhríomhar sa chontae agus go bhfuil ról tábhachtach ag ealaíontóirí agus ag eagraíochtaí chontae an Chláir maidir le forbairt an chláir bhlianúil ealaíon. ### Chief Executive's Foreword

I GCOMHAR LEIS an Meitheal Chultúir, tá straitéis chuimsitheach cruthaithe ag Comhairle Chontae an Chláir don tréimhse 2018–2022.

Tá plean gníomhaiochta don bliain 2018 ann in éindí leis an straitéis seo agus déanfar plean bliantúil a fhorbairt chui le bliain faoi cheannasaiocht an Stiúrthóra Forbartha Sóisialta agus Chomhordaitheoir Éire Ildánach an Chláir.

## An Cultúr agus an Chruthaitheacht í gContae an Chláir

### Culture and Creativity in Clare

IS LEOR SRACFHÉACHAINT ar léarscáil an Chláir lena thuscint gur ceantar imeallach é ar an-chuid bealaí. De chomhcheilg gheografach, feidhmíonn Abhainn na Sionainne agus An tAigéan Atlantach chun é a scoitheadh amach go hiomlán, nach mór, de na contaetha comharsanacha máguaird. Agus is cosúil go ndeachaigh an t-eisiachas tíreolaíoch seo i gcion ar an léarscáil pholaitiúil chomh maith. Ón uair gur scoitheadh é de Chonnacht, áit is dual dó a bheith ó thaobh an luí thíreolaíoch de, is cosúil, ag tréimhsí eágusa i ndiaidh an chéad scoite sin, gurbh ann don Chlár (nó Tuadhmmhumhan, mar a thugtaí air tráth) mar thalamh chríche thairseachúil, de chineál, a gabhadh isteach i gConnacht ar uaireanta, agus ar uaireanta eile sa Mhumhan. Is áit iargúlta ann féin é An Clár go dtí an lá inniu féin, ar bhealach, ós é an t-aon chontae i gCúige Mumhan atá ar an taobh thiar d' Abhainn na Sionainne. **A** GLANCE AT THE map will show that county Clare is in many respects a peripheral region. The River Shannon and the Atlantic have combined to form a near total circumfluence which separates the county from virtually all of its neighbours. And this geographical exclusiveness would seem to have impacted on the political landscape as well. Originally wrested from Connacht, to which it was geographically attached, at several periods in its subsequent history Co. Clare, or Thomond as it was once called, appears to have existed as a kind of liminal borderland annexed sometimes to Connacht, sometimes to Munster. Even to this day Clare remains something of an outland, being the only Munster county west of the Shannon. Thomas Westropp, Antiquarian, put the geographical and cultural contours of Clare most succinctly when he said that "the county was surrounded on three sides by water and by the enmity of Connacht on the fourth".

Our sense of culture is intrinsically linked to our sense of identity. R.S. Thomas portrays this as "we only know who we are by knowing where we are. A particular place creates around us a unique culture that gives us not only our identity, but also our vision and values." It follows then that our values and understanding of our cultural heritage will inform our actions in the future. Clare is a county of many contrasts and historically a land clearly defined by those

Ceapadh Brian Boru (Brian Bóruma Mac Cennétig, Sean-Ghaeilge) Chill DáLua ina Ardri ar Éirinn agus ba dhaingean Gaelach é An Clár i bhfad i ndiaidh theacht na Normannach. Muireadhach Ó Briain a ceapadh ina chéad Iarla ar Thuadhmmhumhan sa bhliain 1543 agus, ó shin i leith, aithnítear an t-ainm Brianach a bheith dlúthcheangailte le Contae an Chláir.

who have lived here and left their marks on the landscape. The natural and built heritage of the county is vast, it represents unique features as well as many of the best examples of their kind in the country and further afield. Indeed Ireland's earliest evidence of human occupation comes from Clare – a worked bear patella from a cave at Edenvale near Ennis dates from the Palaeolithic period around 10,500 BC. A Mesolithic shell midden from Fanore provides proof of later hunter gatherers along the North Burren coastal region and Neolithic evidence comes from the numerous tombs scattered throughout the county including the famous dolmen at Poulnabrone and the Burren's numerous wedge tombs.

Christianity left a strong imprint on the landscape of Clare – early monastic sites abound from St Senan's foundation on Scattery Island to St Caimin in Inis Cealtra on Lough Derg to St Tola at Dysert O'Dea. The continental monastic orders arrived from the twelfth century with houses of Augustinian Canons at Clare Abbey and Canon Island, Cistercians at Corcomroe in the Burren and Franciscans at Ennis and Quin. A nunnery of Augustinian Canonesses was founded at Killone also. The Gaelic Clare clans included McMahons, MacNamaras and O'Loghens and other septs of the Dál gCais with the name of O'Brien prominent above all. Brian Ború became High King of Ireland from his base at Killaloe and Clare remained a Gaelic stronghold long after the arrival of the Anglo-Normans. Murrough O'Brien became the first Earl of Thomond in 1543 and the O'Brien name remained synonymous with Clare until modern times.

Maitear é a bheith ar an dán is clútiúla sa Ghaeilge. Is i bhfoirm físe, nó 'aislinge' atá sé. Is réaltaí domhanda iad leithéidi Edna O'Brien agus Niall Williams. Tá ábhar shaothar an Bhrianaigh faoi thionchar na scéaláiochta agus na staire áitiúla agus faoi thréithe tíreolaíocha ar leith de chuid an chontae amhail fáinní Draoithe agus oiléán naofa Inis Cealtra i Loch Deirgirt. Sa bliain 2015, in agallamh a thug Niall Williams, údar a rugadh i mBaile Átha Cliath ach a bhfuil cónaí air i gContae an Chláir le breis is 20 bliain fiafraíodh de cén áit sa domhan a bhfillean sé air i gcónai agus cén fáth a bhfillean sé ar an áit sin agus d'fhreagair sé: "The sea at Doughmore, County Clare, it blows open your soul". Toisc chinnteacht na gCláiríneach faoi inspioráid na tríológe The Lord of the Rings, le J.R.R. Tolkien, a bheith gitte i mBoirinn, bunaíodh Féile J.R.R. Tolkien siar i 2014. From this configuration of ancient landscape, sea and dominant peoples sprung a culture rich in written and musical expression. Poetry and poets abound in the county to this day but one famous poet perhaps stands above the others, Brian Merriman, writing in his native Irish language, penned an epic poem of well over a thousand lines. It has been translated into English as "The Midnight Court" by many translators. The principal themes are the plight of young women who lack husbands, clerical celibacy, free love, and the misery of a young woman married to a withered old man. It is probably the most famous poem in the Irish language. It is written in the form of a vision or "aisling". Luminaries on the world stage in the literary tradition include Edna O'Brien and Niall Williams. The content of O'Brien's work has been coloured by local lore and history and by distinctive geographic features of the county such as Druids' circles and Holy Island (Inis Cealtra) in Lough Derg. County Clare remains so much in O'Brien's veins that the people here continue to find themselves in her works. Niall Williams, an author born in Dublin but living in Clare for over 20 years, was asked in 2015 where in the world he found himself returning to and why? His answer was – "The sea at Doughmore, County Clare, it blows open your soul". So certain are locals that J.R.R. Tolkien drew on the Burren for his inspiration for the Lord of the Rings trilogy that a J.R.R. Tolkien festival was established back in 2014. This unique gathering is a celebration of the eerie beauty of the Burren area, which is believed to have been a considerable influence on J.R.R. Tolkien's work. The untamed, rugged local landscape, including a cave known as Poll na gColm (pronounced 'Pole na Gollum'), as well as elements of Irish mythology, may have provided inspiration for Tolkien's creation of Middle Earth.

Sainmharc na nGael ab ea an laochas spóirt i gcónai agus ba de thoradh ar fhís an Chláirínigh, Mícheál

Cíosóig, a d'eascair paisean na nGael i leith na gcluichí Gaelacha. Rugadh sa Charn é sa bhliain 1847 agus bhí sé ar dhuine de na daoine ba mhó a chuaigh i gcion ar chúrsaí a linne. Tá fágtha le hoidhreacht ag an gCíosógach go bhfuil breis agus 1,600 club de chuid an CLG i sráidbhailte agus i mbaile na tíre, gan trácht ar a bhfuil de chlubanna sa Ríocht Aontaithe, i Stáit Aontaithe Mheiriceá, san Astráil agus i dtíortha eile nach iad. Agus féach go bhfuil mallacht bhlianta na 1930adaí díbeartá ag foirne an Chláir mar thoradh ar Chraobh na hÉireann san Iománaíochta bhuachaint sna blianta 1995, 1997 agus 2013.

Is leor spléachadh ar chuid de thraigisiún an Chláir le go dtuigfí a bheoga agus atá an cultúr sa chontae. Is ann d'fhéile Mheán an Fhómhair i gcónaí, uair a spreagtar cuairteoirí chun 'Cleamhais a Dhéanamh', agus ní beag mar mhaíomh ag Willie Daly, fear déanta na gcleamhais, ar den trúí glúin é, go bhfuil breis agus 3,000 cleamhais déanta aige. Ní hann don rí Feabhra, dar le go leor, mura dtugtar cuairt ar Thobar Beannaithe Bhríde sa Lios Ceannúir, agus is minic le feiceáil fós iad Buachaillí Lá an Dreoilín, agus idir sheinnt agus dhamhsa agus charnadh airgid acú Lá 'le Stiofáin. Is cruthú é seo uile ar an meas síoraí a mhaireann ar oidhreacht agus chultúr sa chontae. Ach tá trraigisiún úra á gcruthú chomh maith – féach foghlaim surfála ar An Leacht nó dúshlán Thonn Aileen faoi Ailltreacha an Mhothair, nó siúl na n-iliomad conair Bhoirneach. Tá fás ar chultúr an bhia sa chontae – i 2017, don chéad uair riagh i gcás tigh thábhairne, bronndadh Réalt Michelin ar an Wild Honey Inn i Lios Dúin Bhearna, gan trácht ar Thigh Uí Mhuirgheasa ar

people of his time and a son of Clare, born in Carron in 1847. Michael Cusack's legacy can be seen in every village and town in the country in the form of over 1,600 GAA clubs with more in the UK, USA, Australia and many other countries across the world. Clare's successful Hurling All Ireland wins in 1995, 1997 and 2013 have finally banished the Biddy Early curse.

A look at some of the traditions in Clare give an insight into the vibrant culture of the county. The matchmaking tradition in Lisdoonvarna is over 150 years old originating with the gentry who came to the spa town to 'take the waters'. The September festival continues to encourage visitors to 'Meet, Match and Make a Life' and third generation matchmaker Willie Daly boasts over 3,000 marriages. Visiting St Brigid's well in Liscannor on the 1st February is a must for many and Wrenboys can still be seen travelling the county on St Stephen's Day playing music, dancing and collecting money. The survival of such traditions are proof of the continuing respect for heritage and culture in the county. But new traditions are also being made – learning to surf in Lahinch or the more daring Aileen's Wave at the Cliffs of Moher, and trekking the many Burren trails. Food culture is growing in popularity, in 2017 the Wild Honey Inn in Lisdoonvarna became the first Irish Pub to win a Michelin Star while Morrisseys of Doonbeg boasts a Michelin Bib Gourmand. And again, in 2017, due recognition was given to the welcoming nature of Clare people when Ennis was named Ireland's friendliest town.

Is sainmharc aitheantaí den Chláir í an fhiontraíocht, rud is suntasaí ar fad i gcás bhunú Aerfort na Sionainne. Bunaíodh an t-aerfort féin i 1942, agus ba ann, i 1947, a osclaíodh an chéad siopa ar domhan a bhí saor ó dhleacht, a bhuíochas sin do fhís Bhreandáin Úi Riagáin. Ba é an ceannródaí céanna a bhunaigh Zón Saorthrádála na Sionainne i 1959 – zón a bhfuil achar 600 acra ann anois, 200 foirgneamh agus 100 comhlacht atá ag tacú le 7,000 post sa cheantar. Ba é bunú Bhaile na Sionna sna seascaídí sméar mhullaigh na hiarrachta agus tá d'immheacht anois ag an Zón Saorthrádála agus an tAerfort Idirnáisiúnta freastal ar mhargáí na hEorpa, an Mheán-Oirthir, na hAfraice, na hÁise agus eile. Ba éacht eile sa Chláir í i laethanta luanthe am Stáit mar a chuaigh an contae i bhfeiliúint don fhorbairt infrastruchtúir ba ghá in Ard na Croise sna 1920adaí – scéim hidriileictreach a críochnaíodh taobh istigh d'achar 7 mblíana tar éis bhunú an Stáit Neamhspleách, agus ar chostas aon chíúgiú de bhuiséad náisiúnta an ama, agus féach go bhfuil sí ag feidhmiú léi i gcónaí. Le blianta beaga anuas, tá Stáisiún Cumhachta Ghob na Muine, gar do Chill Rois, ar cheann de na stáisiúní ghinte leictreachais is mó in Éirinn. Nach ar mhac Lios Ceannúir féin, John Philip Hammond (ceapadóir an chéad fhomhuiréain) a bheadh an bród toisc ionchur a chontae dúchais i bhforbairt an Stáit i ndiaidh bháis dó.

Entrepreneurship has been a hallmark of Clare identity – demonstrated most notably in the establishment of Shannon. The Airport was established in 1942 with the world's first duty free opening in 1947, the brainchild of Brendan O'Regan. This visionary created the Shannon Free Zone in 1959 – now covering 600 acres, 200 buildings, housing 100 companies and supporting 7,000 jobs in the area. The foundation of Shannon Town in the 1960s completed the project and the Free Zone and International Airport now have the potential to serve markets in Europe, the Middle East, Africa, Asia and beyond. Another major feat in Clare was the facilitation of a national infrastructural development early on in the history of the State, Ardnacrusha in the 1920's – the Shannon hydroelectric scheme was completed within 7 years of Irish Independence at a cost of one fifth of the Irish State's annual budget at the time and is still generating power today. In recent years, the Moneypoint Power Generating Station near Kilrush is one of Ireland's largest electricity generation stations. John Philip Holland of Liscannor (the inventor of the submarine) would have been notably proud of his county's contribution to the development of the state after his lifetime.

Support to the Arts has always been a commitment of Clare County Council with the Local Authority leading the way with the establishment of the first Arts Officer in the country in 1985. Over 30 years later the arts continue to flourish with opportunities for

performance and exhibitions at glór, Ennis and Cultúrlann Sweeney, Kilkee. The creation of artist studios in Tulla, Ennistymon and most recently Ennis supports visual artists in making work in Clare, and offers young artists the opportunity to stay at home. International artists such as Sir Frederick William Burton and Sydney Nolan have been inspired by the county while contemporary artists such as Samuel Walsh, Mick O'Dea PRHA and Deirdre O'Mahony are considered leading Clare artists, nationally and internationally. The acclaimed Burren College of Art, with a backdrop against the inspiring Burren landscape in Ballyvaughan, attracts dozens of international students annually.

The people of Clare need little encouragement to actively participate in the arts. Programmes such as the Artist in Schools scheme, the Embrace Arts & Disability Programme and events such as the Bealtaine festival, reach members of the community of Clare that may otherwise find it difficult to access the arts. Culture in the community abounds, with nightly music sessions taking place countywide and local drama groups attracting huge audiences for their staged productions in community centres and parish halls throughout the county. The talent and role of artists is valued here by local communities, they live amongst us and enrich our lives. The Local Authority supported venue at glór in Ennis is a leading arts centre for audiences, artists and communities providing consistent quality arts experiences.

Creative Ireland is the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in Culture 2025 – Éire Ildánach. ### Methodology

The values of Creative Ireland Clare have been determined based on an examination of public feedback undertaken through a consultation process which began in March 2017 and recommenced again from December through January in 2018.

### A process of internal engagement across the Local Authority in 2017 included:

One to one section meetings; the establishment of working groups; focus group collaborations between cultural sections; group brainstorming meetings as well as project planning sessions. Two final evaluation meetings also took place in Dec 2017. The team was led by the Director of Service for Social Development and facilitated by an independent professional. The work of community was reflected in particular, through participation in focus group collaborations which included staff, elected representatives, community based groups and organisations, arts specific practitioners, sector specific operators and experts.

### Focus Group Collaborations:

Each section head across Libraries, Arts, Heritage, Museum, glór, Archives, Tourism, Enterprise, Rural Development/Community and Conservation issued a call to engage in public stakeholder meetings. These sessions gave an opportunity to reflect on the mission of each section, its ambition and any barriers to participation by the public. It looked carefully at the role of cultural expression and the creative practitioner. The essence of these sessions is reflected in the values outlined below. The projects that are detailed in the 2018 Activation Plan have come about as a result of this process. They are further measured against their capacity

### Creative Ireland Clare values...

#### Collaboration:

The development of a working Culture Team with the ability to respond and work together on cultural projects on behalf of the county is a cornerstone of the Clare strategy. Creative Ireland Clare values collaboration and respects the expertise and insight of the Culture Team, mobilised as a result of the specialisms held as Local Authority representatives in their unique cultural fields. The idea of collaboration is extended to the citizens of Clare who have right of access to the Creative Ireland Clare programme and who by their very nature, and in their representation as community, are invited to collaborate, lead, shape and determine projects under the programme over the course of the next five years.

#### Communication

Understanding the rationale, reasoning and relevance of the Creative Ireland programme is valued within this strategy as the means by which the people of Clare come to drive, determine and experience the programme in the county. The promotional vehicle for the programme is the County Librarian's Office as Co-ordinator of Creative Ireland Clare. Initiatives highlighting opportunities for grant aid and community direction will be promoted by this office. In addition, the Creative Ireland national office in the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht liaises at local level across all pillars of the strategy, where necessary. Creative Ireland Clare will support

## Community

The national pillar under which Clare County Council is mandated to operate the Creative Ireland programme is ‘to enable creativity in every community’. Creative Ireland Clare values the right of access by the people of Clare to the programme and will work across its five pillars to ensure the national programme is successful in Clare. This strategy welcomes collaboration with communities so that all of our contributions are valued. We acknowledge the unique creativity that we have in our communities and we will work together to ensure that we strengthen our collective creative capacity as a whole through the Creative Ireland programme.

## Participation

Opportunities for access will determine participation in the Creative Ireland programme in Clare. Delivering a programme which in turn is valued by the people of Clare requires the support and determination of the Culture Team. Participation by artists and creative practitioners is central to every project developed in the yearly activation plans which will be delivered under this strategy. Participation by our communities in the creative life of the county will assist in our mandate to support creativity and its role in helping shape vibrant and attractive towns, where communities are strong and work inclusively for the wellbeing of all of its members.

## Inclusivity

Having access to, being a part of and feeling welcome is valued in this strategy. We will work to ensure that the Creative Ireland programme in Clare also includes marginalised communities. We will ensure that resources are carefully applied so that a sense of community, as well as the impact on communities is monitored. We will work to ensure access remains a consistent objective within all projects and programmes that will be developed. Inequality of access is acknowledged and Clare County Council will work to ensure communities of all types find opportunity.

## Empowerment

The Creative Ireland Clare programme has been developed to embrace and enable creative expression and the role of community is vital in delivering a successful programme. Developing competency and confidence in our abilities and acknowledging the key role that creative practitioners play in helping shape and enable creativity is also recognised. Opportunities to express the unique nature of our cultural attributes will be provided through our work as a result of this strategy. We aim to ensure choice and fairness are prioritised in the actions and reflected in the yearly activation plans (Appendix 1: 2018 Activation Plan). In Clare, we will work on an Audit of Local Cultural & Creative Resources over the five year programme. This will amass in one portal, a directory of valuable creative people, organisations, networks, community buildings and creative spaces that make up the assets in our communities. We will work to enhance our creative and cultural profile by ensuring that resources in our communities are available to all and are relevant to their purpose.

Tá liosta de na straitéisí cultúrtha ar fáil in Agusín 3. Chun straitéisí a ailníú, iarradh ar an Meitheal Cultúir tionscnaimh a shainaithint a thugann deiseanna ar an gcomhoibriú ar fáil d'fhonn cur i gcrích a chinntíú. I gcás gach aon tionscnamh a luaitear thíos, liostaítear é faoi phríomhthéama nó faoi phríomhthosaíocht ar leith, tá sé uimhrithe, tá teideal ar an tionscnamh, luaitear rannóg cheannais leis, luaitear príomh-pháirtithe, tá tráthchlár ann maidir le cur i gcrích, tá leithroinnt buiséad ann agus luaitear méadracht stádais (idir lámha, tosaithe nó gan tosú fós).

D'eascair na Tosaíochtaí Straitéiseacha as tuiscint atá forbartha i leith na n-acmhainní seachtracha atá ar fáil don chlár i gcontae an Chláir agus, ina theallta sin, i leith chumas Chomhairle Chontae an Chláir na tosaíochtaí atá leagtha amach a chomhlíonadh. Beidh solúbthacht ann le linn thréimhse na straitéise, le go mbeifear in ann leas a bhaint as acmhainní úra cultúrtha a thagann chun cinn. **A** PRIMARY PURPOSE of the Creative Ireland five-year strategy is to bring coherence to individual culture-based strategies that have already been created by the disciplines within the Culture Team in Clare. A list of the culture based strategies is provided in Appendix 3. In order to align strategies, the Culture Team were required to identify projects which offer opportunity for collaborative practice to ensure delivery. Each project detailed below is listed under a key theme or priority, it is numbered, has a project title, a section lead, key partners, a timeframe for delivery, a budget allocation and a status metric (underway, commenced or not commenced).

The Strategic Priorities have evolved by developing an understanding of the available external resources to the programme in Clare as well as the capacity of Clare County Council to deliver on the priorities outlined. This intention will remain fluid throughout the lifetime of the strategy as new cultural and creative resources develop. The Strategic Priorities themes in Clare are as follows:

#### Priority 1

Create opportunities to access innovative culture based programmes and projects

#### Priority 2

Develop the county's creative capacity and reputation

#### Priority 3

Nurture the creative sector and its infrastructures

#### Priority 4

Work collaboratively to develop cultural expression and wellbeing

#### Tosaíocht 5

Déanfaidh an Fhoireann Chultúir tionscnaimh úra a chothú, tacóidh siad lena gcur i bhfeidhm agus déanfaidh siad comhoibriú len iad a fhorbairt. Táthar tar éis tionscnaimh atá nua, lena ngabhallan méid áirithe maoine intleachtúla agus a chuireann deiseanna rannpháirtíochta ar fail do phobail an Chláir a fhorbairt faoin tosaíocht seo. Tá sé mar aidhm aici deis a sholáthar le haghaidh léiriú cultúr ar bhealach chomh corraitheach agus is féidir.

#### Cuspóirí:

- Athbhunú Sráidbhaile ó Aimsir an Ghorta:** I gcomhar leis an bpobal, glacfaidh Músaem an Chláir agus Cartlann an Chontae ceannasaíocht ar thionscnamh ina ndíreofar a gcuid acmhainní ar eispéireas barántúil oidhreachta a fhorbairt. Roghnófar sráidbhaile tréigthe ó aimsir an ghorta agus, thar achar cùig bliana, déanfar tochailt chun léargas a fháil ar an saol sa Chlár i láir an 19ú haois. Glacfar cur chuige taighdeach ildisciplíneach a mbeidh an pobal páirteach ann. Mar chuid den tionscnamh, déanfar caidreamh le pobal an Chláir agus le Diaspóra na hÉireann, ar sainrud oidhreachta do mhórchuid díobh é, rud a neartóidh féiniúlacht Éireannach an Diaspóra agus a fheabhsóidh mórtas i measc mhuintir an Chláir

#### Priority 5

Map the cultural and creative landscape in the county

The five priorities include a programme of detailed objectives for 2018 on the following pages:

#### Priority 1: Create opportunities to access innovative culture based programmes and projects

The Culture Team will encourage innovative projects, support their implementation and work collaboratively to develop them. Projects which are new, which offer up a degree of intellectual property and which offer opportunities for communities in Clare to participate in a new way have been developed under this priority. The aim is to provide opportunity for cultural expression in as exciting a way as possible.

#### Objectives:

- Recovery of a Famine Village:** Clare Museum and Clare County Archives will head up a project that will utilise their resources to engage with the community for the development of an authentic heritage experience. A famine village will be identified and over a period of five years, targeted excavations will be conducted to shed light on life in mid-19th century Clare. A multi-disciplinary approach to research and interpretation will involve community groups. The project will engage with the wider Clare population and the Irish Diaspora, for which the famine is a key event in the heritage of many, strengthening a sense of Irish identity to the Diaspora and enhancing a sense of pride among Clare people.

- Turais & Cainteanna Ailtireachta i dTithe Oscailte:** Leagfaidh an Rannóg Caomhantais agus Ailtireachta bém ar thithe stáiriúla sa chontae agus aird á tabhairt freisin ar ailtireacht nua-aoiseach agus ar ailtireacht chomhaimseartha. Is é is aidhm dó seo ná plé a chur chun cinn faoin oidhreacht fhoirgnithe, faoi fhiúntas na hoidhreachta sin agus faoin mbaint atá aici le glúnta atá imithe gan trácht ar a tionchar ar thuiscintí faoin dearthóireacht sa chontae.
- Comhoibriú Idirghlúine maidir le Damhsa & Ceol:** Faoi stiúir Rannóg na nEalaíon, forbrófar complacht na n-óg sna healaíona i gceantar na Sionna agus gníomhóidh sé sin mar eiseamláir phíolótach don chontae uile. Tá tionscnamh san ealaín phoiblí á choimisiú ag Comhairle Chontae an Chláir ar tionscnamh é a fheabhsóidh caidreamh an phobail le daoine óga agus le grúpaí pobail eile, trí mheán an damhsa chomhaimseartha, rus a chruthóidh tionscadal idirghlúine. Roghnófar damhsóir chun bheith ag oibriú go comhoibríoch le Clann Rusangano. Tá a mbranda sainiúil féin den cheol á bhunú agus á fhorbairt thar achar ama ag na daoine óga seo. D'ainneoin cúrlaí cultúrtha éagsúla a bheith ag baill an ghrúpa, is iad an fhéiniúlacht agus an dúchás a bhíonn faoi chaibidil acu. Cuirfear an toradh deiridh i láthair an phobail, nó seans go ndéanfar scannánú air. Bheadh se i gceist go ndéanfaí aithris ar an gcur chuige seo ar fud an chontae.
- Ailiniú na Scoileanna á stiúradh ag Glór (GASP):** Clár do Scoileanna faoi stiúir Glór chun cur le caidreamh scoileanna na hInse agus scoileanna an chontae uile, i dtaca le clár Glór do dhaoine óga. Tá Glór dírithe ar fheabhsú an chaidrimh atá aige le scoileanna

- Open House Architecture Tours & Talks:** The Conservation and Architecture Section will highlight historical homes in the county with a focus also on modernism and contemporary architecture. The aim is to promote conversation with regard to our built heritage, its merit and associations to previous generations as well as its impact on the design consciousness of the county.
- Intergenerational Dance & Music Collaboration:** Led by the Arts Section this project will build a youth arts collective in the Shannon area which will act as pilot model for the county. Clare County Council are commissioning a public art project, which will enhance community engagement with young people and other community groups through the medium of contemporary dance, creating an inter-generational project. A dance artist will be selected to work collaboratively with the Rusangano Family. These young musicians have been creating and steadily building their own unique brand of music. Despite their diverse cultural backgrounds, the group explore issues such as identity and belonging. The finished works will be performed publicly or possibly filmed. The intention is that the model would be replicated countywide.
- Glór arts for schools programme led by glór in Ennis (GASP):** A Schools Programme led by glór to enhance engagement of schools in Ennis and across the County with glór's cultural programme for young people. glór is working to improve its engagement with schools and increase their attendance and participation at the theatre as audience members to ensure they have a range of experience of the performing and visual arts at various stages in their education. This

- Tionscnamh Turasóireachta a chothaíonn ceangal idir Drámaíocht Phobail agus Oibreoirí Turasóireachta trí fhoghlaím, trí fhóraim agus trí thaibhiúcháin – eiseamláir do shainbhailte:** Déanfar cumhacht na drámaíochta pobalbhunaithe dúshlán agus spreagadh a thabhairt, mar aon le mórtas áite a léiriú, a fhorbairt ar mhodh ina meallfar luchtanna féachana ar mian leo a bheith rannpháirteach i réimse na hamharclannaíochta ar leibhéal pobail agus ar mian leo tuiscint a fháil air sin. will be achieved through the establishment of an Educational Advisory Group, made up of a representation of primary and secondary teachers and principals as well as key educational advisors from the county. This group in intended to both help inform the arts programme offer at glór whilst also aiding the promotion of the glór young people's programme to students and their teachers. With Creative Ireland support it is intended to develop and deliver a schools programme for a number of primary schools and secondary schools to engage more regularly and actively with the glór programme, with subsidised or free tickets to help reduce the financial obstacles to accessing glór performances and exhibitions.

- A Tourism Project linking community drama to tourism operators through learning, forums and performance – a model for key towns:** The power of community based drama to challenge and excite as well as offer the sense of place experience will be developed so that it attracts audiences who wish to engage and understand theatre at community level. The pilot will develop in Doonbeg in 2018 and 2019, as part of the West Clare Drama Festival and, it is intended, will thereafter, be replicated as a model for key towns across the county.

#### Cuspóirí:

- Scéim na nDeontas, Éire Ildánach an Chláir:** Is scéim í seo a chuidíonn le pobail atá cruthaitheacha ó thaobh cúrsaí cultúrtha de a fhorbairt. Cuirfear céadán de na cistí bliantúla ar leataobh do phobail, do ghrúpaí, do dhaoine aonair agus d'eagrais ar mian leo tionscnaimh nuálacha uathúla a fhorbairt a chuirfidh le cumas agus stádas cruthaitheach an chontae. Is deis oscailte í seo a bheidh dírithe ar aidhmeanna chlár Éire Ildánach a chomhlónadh.
- Briceadaíl Breacadaíl (The Doodle House) – Tionscadal Dearthóireachta de chuid Scoileanna Ildánacha:** Is tionscnamh é seo a bheidh faoi stiúir na Rannóige um Chaomhnú agus Pleanáil agus a bheidh

### Priority 2: Develop the county's creative capacity and reputation

The Culture Team will aim to foster and empower citizens to build on established success and strive to “raise the bar” in creative endeavours undertaken and imagined. Exploring and developing the very real power of creativity and creative expression is a priority here. Integrating creativity and acknowledging the very vital role it plays in empowering communities, developing new ways of doing things and new forms of collaboration are integral aspects of this theme.

#### Objectives:

- Creative Ireland Clare Grants Scheme** that assists in the development of culturally creative communities. A percentage of annual funds will be ring-fenced for communities, groups, individuals and organisations who wish to develop innovative and unique projects which build creative capacity and reputation for the county. This will be an open call opportunity, defined to embrace the principles of the Creative Ireland programme.
- The Doodle House –A Creative Schools Design Project:** Led by the Conservation and Planning Section, this project targets the primary and second level student body to consider structure, shape, form and function. It asks participants to determine

- Tuiscint ar an Tírdhreach –Tionscadal do Phobail a bhaineann le hOidhreacht na Timpeallachta:** Is den riachtanas é úsáid ghlé na samhlaíochta le linn tuiscint a fháil ar cháilíochtaí dúchasacha na timpeallachta atá thart orainn ina gcuimsítear an oidhreacht fhoirgnithe agus an oidhreacht nádúrtha, acmhainní agus infrastruktúr. Iarrfar ar scoileanna, ar phobail agus ar ghrúpaí iarscoile ar fud an chontae breathnú ar an timpeallacht mar chás-staidéar ar ‘mhiocracosma’ ina mbainfear úsáid phraictíúil as teicníochtaí taighde allamhúig. Cuirfidh daoine cruthaitheacha tuiscintí agus míreanna físiúla ar fáil le go n-athshamhlófar an rud is dual don duine maidir le háit agus ceantar.
- Compánaigh Chultúrtha –Tionscadal Cruthaitheach Idirghluíne chun an t-uaigneas tuithe a laghdú agus chun cuidíú leis an bhfoghlaim dhigiteach:** Is tionscnamh de chuid Deiseanna do Aosáigh é seo atá ann cheana fén agus a bheidh á stiúradh ag Oifigeach Chairdeas na nAosach sa Chlár, faoi bhrat na Stiúrthóireachta um

user needs and the extent to which design plays a role in the structures that we live in and use on a daily basis. Raw materials as well as digital tools will be used to help shape and determine constructions. Participants develop group and individual projects as well as receive insight into design history and contemporary architecture. This project aligns with pillar one of the Creative Ireland Programme to ‘enable the creative potential of every child’

- Reading The Landscape –A landscape environmental heritage project for communities:** Understanding the inherent qualities of the environment around us, the built and natural, the resources and infrastructures requires active use of imagination. Schools, communities and after school groups will be invited right across the county to look at the landscape as a ‘microcosm’ case study for the practical application of field techniques. Interpretation and visualisations will be interjected by creatives so that a sense of place or essence of an area gets to be re-imagined.
- Cultural Companions –a creative Intergenerational Project to reduce rural isolation and assist digital learning:** This is an existing Age and Opportunity initiative which will be led by the Rural Development Directorate through the Age Friendly Officer in Clare. It is an integrated project, which will not only link networks of communities of people of all ages but offer opportunities for the exchange of skills through the intergenerational element. It is an enabling project connecting generations through a variety of creative forms and experiences in a structured, yet fluid environment.

- Fhorbairt Tuaithe. Is tionscadal comhtháite é a dhéanfaidh idir ghréasáin de phobail den uile aois a nascadh agus deiseanna ar mhalartú scileanna a chruthú tríd an ngné idirghlúine den tionscadal. Is tionscadal cumasúchán é a dhéanfaidh ceangal idir glúnta trí bhíthin cineálacha éagsúla cruthaitheachta agus eispéiris éagsúla cruthaitheachta i dtimpeallacht struchtúrtha a mbeidh gné solúbtha ag baint léi.
- **Ceardlanna i Scríobh Cuimhní Cinn le Grúpaí Scríbhneoirí Pobail sna cúig cheantair de chuid Leabharlann Chontae an Chláir:** Clár sa scríbhneoireacht chruthaitheach ina mbeidh an bhéim ar scríobh cuimhní cinn. Foghlaimeoidh na rannpháirtithe conas a gcuimhní saoil a spreagadh trí úsáid a bhaint as teicnící foghlama deas-inchinne / clé-inchinne agus conas cuimhní cinn a ghéarú, a fhorbairt agus a struchtúrú. Forbróidh agus neartóidh na rannpháirtithe a gcuumas scríbhneireachta féin le linn an ama agus tabharfar aiseolas dóibh agus iad i mbun cuimhní cinn a fhorbairt. Beifear ag súil leis go ndéanfaidh na rannpháirtithe saothar gearr faoina gcuimhní cinn a thabhairt chun críche in imeacht an chláir. Beidh ócaid léitheoreachta ann do gach grúpa mar chuid den chláir.
  - **Ceardlanna Filíochta do Pháistí i gCraobhleabharlanna an Chláir:** Déanfaidh seo an deis a chur ar fáil do thaighde, do chumadh agus do chur i láthair na filíochta. Cuirfidh craobhleabharlanna an Chláir ceardlanna san filíocht ar fáil do ranganna ar an mbunleibhéal scolaíocha. Faoi dheireadh na sraithe teagaisc beidh cur amach ag na páistí ar sheárrá difriúla filíochta, beidh a ndánta féin scríofa acu, agus iad curtha i láthair do lucht féachana

- **Memoir Writing workshops with community writing groups within the five regions of Clare County Library:** A creative writing programme with a focus on memoir writing. Participants will learn how to trigger memories from life experiences using right-brain/left-brain learning techniques, and how to focus, develop and structure memoir. Throughout the programme participants will develop and strengthen their writing voice and receive feedback on their work as they develop a short memoir. It is expected that participants will fully develop a short memoir throughout the programme. The programme will also include a reading event for all writing groups.
- **Children's Poetry Workshops in Clare Libraries** will set the scene for exploring, creating and performing poetry. Clare Libraries will host poetry workshops with primary school class groups. By the end of the series of workshops children will have learned about different poetry genres, created their own poems and presented the poems to an audience. This project aligns with pillar one of the Creative Ireland Programme to 'enable the creative potential of every child.'

Freastalóidh múinteoir fichille ar an leabharlann go seachtainiúil thar achar 10 seachtaine agus í mar aidhm leis an iarracht go mbunófar club fichille ann a leanfar de i ndiaidh don tionscadal a bheith thart. Tá sé cruthaithe gur gléas é an fhicheall a chuidíonn le scileanna léitheoreachta agus ríomhaireachta na bpáistí.   - **Lá na Léitheoirí mar cheiliúradh ar acmhainní agus litríocht i gCraobhleabharlanna an Chláir:** Cuimseoidh sé seo laethanta fáilte i gCraobhleabharlanna ina n-eagraítear ócáidí a bhaineann le réimse na leabhar. Cuirfidh na Laethanta Fáilte seo le cumas na Leabharlainne chun cláir áitiúla a chur ar fáil mar phríomhbhealaí le haghaidh páirteachas pobail, mar a shamhláitear sin faoi Cholún 2 de straitéis Éire Ildánach i.e. 'scód a ligean n le cumas na cruthaitheachta i ngach leanbh'. D'fhéadfá go gceanglófaí na laethanta ceiliúrtha seo le Cruinniú, ceiliúradh náisiúnta na dteaghlaigh i mí an Mheithimh, nó le Lá Náisiúnta na Filíochta.
  - **Cruinniú – Lá Cultúrtha Cruthaitheach na Clainne:** Déanfar an ócáid náisiúnta seo a fhorbairt mar cheiliúradh bliantúil i bhfeilireimeachtaí féile an Chláir. Cé go lonnófar croílár na féile thart ar Glór, in Inis, is é atá

beartaithe ná go ndéanfaidh pobail éagsúla an chontae ceiliúradh ar a gcultúr agus a gcruthaitheacht trí chlár imeachtaí a chruthú a thugann aird ar shócmhainní cultúrtha an chontae trí ghníomhaíochtaí agus trí imeachtaí atá thírithe ar an teaghlach agus atá feiliúinach ar bhonn aoise a chur ar siúl gach bliain ar an lá sin i mí an Mheithimh.

- **Clár Smaointeoireachta Cruthaitheach do réimse na Fiontraíochta:** Is plean é seo a bheidh faoi riar ag Oifig Fiontraíochta Áitiúil an Chláir trína ndíreofar ar chliaint ar gá dóibh seasamh siar ó riadarbh laethúil an ghnó le go ndéanfar athbhreithniú cruthaitheach ar bhealaí chun an gnó sin a chur chun cinn d'ainneoin acmhainní srianta a bheith ann. Áireofar ról na cruthaitheachta i ndáil le spreagadh gníomhaíochta gnó sa chlár seo.

### Tosaíocht 3: An Earnáil Chruthaitheach, agus an tInfrastruchtúr a bhaineann léi, a Chothú

Tá éagsúlacht sa phobal cruthaitheach i gContae an Chláir agus oibríonn na cleachtóirí sna réimsí seo a leanas: gnó, turasóireacht, oidhreacht, mísaeim, na healaíona, dearthóireacht, ceardaíocht, fógraíocht, ailtireacht, ceol, scannánaíocht agus na meáin dhigiteacha. Tá gá le haitheantas a thabhairt don tallann agus le tacú leis an bhforbairt phroifisiúnta ar gach leibhéal agus i measc daoine ag a bhfuil cumaí éagsúla. Mar thúsphointe, direoidh Éire Ildánach an Chláir ar thacú le cleachtóirí cruthaitheacha in earnálacha na n-ealaón agus na fiontraíochta, agus ar chothú na gcleachtóirí sin. Is mar a leanas a bhainfear an méid sin amach:

- **Creative Thinking Programme for Enterprise.** Co-ordinated by the Local Enterprise Office Clare. A plan to target clients who need time out of the day to day running of a small business, to focus and rethink using creative techniques, developing new ways to grow their business despite limited resources. The role of creativity in stimulating economic activity will be included.

### Priority 3: Nurture the creative sector and its infrastructures

The creative sector is diverse in County Clare with practitioners operating across business, tourism, heritage, museum, the arts, design, craft, advertising, architecture, music, film and digital media. There is a requirement to acknowledge talent and to support professional development at all levels and across all capacities. Creative Ireland Clare will look to support and nurture creative practitioners in the arts and in enterprise in the first instance. We will do this in the following ways:

### Cuspóirí:

- **Lárionad do Chruthaitheoirí i bhfoirm fóram/gréasáin ar leith mar chuidíú do chleachtóirí cruthaitheacha:** Le linn na ngrúpaí fócais, labhair na healaíontóirí ar an ngá le teacht le chéile chun spás agus pleananna agus smaointe agus tionscadail a chomhroinnt ar bhonn níos minice. Is smaoineamh simplí é seo trína dtabharfadhl éalaíontóirí proifisiúnta ceardlanna dá gcomhchruthaitheoirí chun iad a spreagadh agus chun eolas a chur ar fáil i leith a gcuid saothar. Beidh sé mar aidhm ag na ceardlanna idir eolas agus oideachas agus úroliúint a thabhairt, agus pobal a chur ar fáil ina mbeidh éalaíontóirí proifisiúnta agus éalaíontóirí amaitéaracha aithne a chur ar a chéile, fóglaim óna chéile agus smaointe a mhalartú. Táthar ag súil go bhfreastalóidh téamaí agus ábhar na gceardlann ar ábhar spéise agus agus riachtanaí na n-ealaíontóirí, is é Glór a chomhordóidh na ceardlanna agus a ghníomhóidh mar óstach ina leith.
- **Déanfaidh oifig Éire Ildánach an Chláir comhoibriú i gcomhar leis na pobail agus na páirtithe chun an clár a riadarbh agus a chur chun cinn sa chontae:** Is ar bhailí gach aon Mheithle Cultúr a bheidh an dualgas maidir le tiomsú an ábhair le haghaidh imeachtaí agus ócáidí poiblíochta, ach is í an oifig lárnach a thacóidh le clár uathúil chontae an Chláir agus a chuirfidh an clár sin in iúl ar gach ardán margáiochta as líne agus ar líne. Dáilfear sciar beag den chiste ar riarrachán, ar chípéisíochta agus ar mheasúnú. Déanfar ailíníú le feachtas mhargaíochta náisiúnta.

### Objectives:

- **A Creators' Hub as a dedicated forum/network to assist creative practitioners:** At the focus groups, artists spoke about the need to come together, to share a space more often, and share their plans, ideas and projects. This is a simple idea to present workshops by professional artists for fellow creators to inspire and inform their work. Workshops will aim to inform, educate, and upskill and provide a community for independent professional artists as well as amateur artists to bond, cross-pollinate, and exchange. It is hoped the themes and content of the workshops will be informed by the needs and interests of artists, which will be co-ordinated and hosted by glór.
- **The Creative Ireland Clare office will work collaboratively embracing communities and partners to administer and promote the programme in the county.** The compilation of content for events and promotions will remain the responsibility of each Culture Team member but the central co-ordinating office will support and communicate the unique nature of Clare's programme in all offline and online marketing platforms. A small portion of fund will be used for administration, documentation and evaluation. Alignment with national marketing campaigns will be undertaken.

- Aistriúchán ar Éire Ildánach – Straitéis Chultúir & Chruthaitheachta an Chláir:** Cuirfear cóipeanna d'aistriúchán Gaeilge an doiciméid ar fáil agus aithníonn an Straitéis ról sainiúil na teanga i bhféiniúlacht na tíre. Cuirfear céadán beag de chiste an chláir ar leataobh gach bláin chun a chinntí go mbeidh dóthain cóipeanna den Straitéis agus den phlean gníomhaíochta bliantúil ar fáil don phobal.
- Bunú Sparánachaí nó Cónaitheachtaí:** Ón mbliain 2019 ar aghaidh, beidh deis ag ealaíontóirí agus ag cleachtóirí cruthaitheacha iarratas ar thacaíocht i leith fhorbairt a gcuid oibre a chur faoi bhráid an chláir. D'fhéadfadh sé go mbainfeadh iarratais den sórt sin le corporas nua oibre a chruthú nó le cur chun cinn aireagáin nua nó le maoin intleachtúil nua. Beidh feidhm ag téarmaí agus coinníollacha. Leagfar béim ar chóras tacaiochta a fhorbairt don earnáil chruthaitheach agus chultúrtha.

#### Tosaíocht 4: Comhoibriú chun go bhforrófar léiriú cultúrtha agus leasa

Tá Meitheal Cultúir Chomhairle Chontae an Chláir bunaithe anois mar mheitheal tras-Stiúrthóireachta agus feidhmíonn sí de réir sraith luachanna agus tosaíochtaí. Tá an comhoibriú lárnach agus riachtanach do bhaint amach na fise atá ag Éire Ildánach an Chláir. Tá cuireadh á thabhairt dár bpobail go léir chun comhoibriú agus chun comhroinnt a dhéanamh ionas gur féidir linn uile a bheith páirteach i mínlú chlár Éire Ildánach an Chláir. Is trí mheán an chur chuige seo a dhéanfar dul chun cinn agus a bhainfear toradh fadtéarmach amach.

- Translations of the Creative Ireland Clare Culture & Creativity Strategy** will be provided in Irish and the Strategy recognises the unique role that the language plays in the identity of the country. A small percentage of funding will be set aside annually to ensure adequate copies of the Strategy and yearly activation plan will be available to the public.
- The establishment of Bursaries or Residencies** from 2019 onwards will allow artists and creative practitioners to make application to the programme for their own work development. This might be in the creation of a new body of work, or for the advancement of a new invention or new intellectual property. Terms and conditions will apply. The focus is on developing a support system for the creative and cultural sector.

#### Priority 4: Work collaboratively to develop cultural expression and wellbeing

The Clare County Council Culture Team is now established as a cross-Directorate team working to a set of values and priorities. Collaboration is central and necessary to realising the Creative Ireland Clare vision. We extend an invitation to co-operate, to share and to collaborate to all our communities so that collectively we can shape the Creative Ireland programme in Clare. It is through this means of working that progress and long term impact can be gained.

#### Cuspóirí:

- BUMBLEance – Tionscadal Litríochta agus Sláinte** do dhaltaí bunscoile sa le linn Fhéile Chlubanna Leabhar na bPáistí: Is iarracht chomhpháirtíochta í seo idir Seirbhís Náisiúnta na nOtharcharr do Leanáí, Leabharlann Chontae an Chláir agus Bunscoileanna, ina bhfeicfear údair litríochta do pháistí in éindí le leabharlannaithe, agus iad ar bord an BUMBLEance. Léifidh na húdair sleachta as a saothair agus casfaidh siad ar dhaltaí as scoileanna ar fud Chontae an Chláir. Díreoidh an tionscadal seo aird na bpáistí ar chúrsai timnis i dtimpeallacht a bheidh idirghníomhach, eolasach agus spraíúil, agus léireoidh sé an dóigh ar féidir leis na daltaí cuidiú agus tacú le páistí atá tinn ar fud na tíre. - Teicníochtaí Cruthaitheacha le Páirteachas Pobail a Chothú:** De thoradh ar chomhráite na ngrúpaí fócais, d'eascair tuiscint ar an ngéarágh atá le cumas cruthaitheach a bheith ag na ceannairí foirne a bheidh ag plé leis na pobail éagsúla agus léiriódh go bhféadfaí próisis chruthaitheacha a úsáid chun cabhrú le pobail réitigh a fhobairt ar shaincheisteanna pobail-bhunaithe agus contae-bhunaithe. Forrófar pleán do bhaill foirne ina leith seo, a bheidh faoi bhrat na Stiúrthóireachta Tuaithé agus a chuirfidh ar chumas na foirne é a úsáid chun an pobal a spreagadh chun ghnímh. Cinnteoidh

#### Objectives:

- BUMBLEance – A Literature and Health project for primary school children during Children Book Club Festival.** A partnership between BUMBLEance, The Children's National Ambulance Service, Clare County Library and Primary Schools will see children's authors and librarians on board BUMBLEance. Authors will read from their work and meet with children across primary schools in County Clare. The initiative will educate young children about illness in an interactive, informative and fun environment and the programme will showcase how children can help and support sick children nationwide. Linking reading with caring for less fortunate children through readings and presentations from popular Irish children's writers, whose books are available in Clare's libraries, will be a new and unique initiative undertaken by Clare County Library.
- Creative Techniques for Community Engagement.** Focus group conversations detailed the very real need for creative capacity among the team of leaders that engage with communities and that creative processes might be used to assist communities develop solutions to community based and county based issues. A Rural Directorate staff familiarisation model for use in community mobilisation will be developed. The action will up-skill all Rural Directorate staff as well as the four incoming Rural Development Officers in Clare, so that creative techniques are taught by professional artists, and shared at community level.

Cuirfidh an t-eolas seo ar ár gcumas dúinn pleanáil i leith acmhainní caipitiúla agus cuinsí oibríochta. Is tosaíocht é go mbeadh a fhios againn cén acmhainn dhaonna, cén luach agus cén méid atá i gceist leis an tallann atá ar fáil sa chontae. #### **Priority 5: Map the cultural and creative landscape in the county**

In order for the county to see and understand the current resources that it has, it is necessary to find a way to locate, map and determine the suitability and usage rate of such resources. Knowing this will allow us to plan for capital resources and operational circumstances. Knowing the human capital, value and degree of talent that is in practice in the county is a priority. This will assist in profiling the creative sector and is developing its needs and assisting its future direction.

#### **Objectives:**

- **An Audit of local cultural and creative resources in Clare.** Bearing in mind all five pillars of Creative Ireland, an audit of urban and rural resources will be carried out so that it informs the annual activation plan of Creative Ireland Clare. Understanding and assessing our creative sector, knowing where to look to engage with artists, creators, spaces and community resources is a key ambition within the Creative Ireland Clare programme. Work on the audit will align with the national roll out of this priority so that the county's resources, buildings and community infrastructures are readily accessible.

**A**N ACTIVATION PLAN will be developed each year throughout the Creative Ireland Clare programme. It will be evaluated based on a national metric.

- Events and other outputs must always relate to the long-term strategic intent. Projects outlined in this document identify specific areas of focus for Creative Ireland Clare in 2018 and these have been devised due to their potential for long-term impact, community engagement, new forms of collaboration and the degree of inter-disciplinary potential.
- The 2018 Activation Plan is detailed in Appendix 1.

#### The Alignment of Internal Culture Based Strategies

The process of aligning strategies has insured that there is no inconsistency between Creative Ireland Clare strategic priorities and the priorities already identified in the various cultural strategies already in place and being acted upon by the Culture Team. As well as identifying strategic priorities arising from existing work, the Culture Team in Clare will stay in place for the duration of the strategy and will meet four times a year, once per quarter. The reporting mechanism through which the strategy will be monitored is the Strategic Policy Committee. The titles of current Culture Based Strategies are detailed in Appendix 3.

- Go dtabharfar tosaíocht síos tríd i gclár Éire Ildánach do léiriú cruthaitheach an chultúir, agus, go háirithe, i réimsí na n-ealaíon, na turasóireachta, na leabharlann, na fiontraíochta, an chaomhantais agus na hoidhreachta.
- Go n-oibreodh Comhairle Chontae an Chláir ar bhealach chomh comhoibríoch agus chomh compháirteach agus is féidir chun tacú le pobail ionas go neartófaí saincheisteanna a bhaineann le rochtain ar an infrastruchtúr agus le léiriú cultúrtha araon.

Consultation with community provided very clear feedback that:

- Access to funds to develop projects under the Creative Ireland theme should be afforded to communities in the form of grant aid.
- That creative practitioners and the role of creativity in the community should be prioritised and highlighted so that artists are employed throughout the Strategy and that the work of creative practitioners is valued and monetised.
- That culture expressed creatively and in particular across the areas of arts, tourism, libraries, enterprise, conservation and heritage should be prioritised throughout the Creative Ireland programme.
- That Clare County Council should work as collaboratively and collectively as possible in the support of communities so that issues of access to
- cultural infrastructure or cultural expression is strengthened.
