IS ÁBHAR RÍMÉID agam, i mo Chathaoirleach dom ar Chomhairle Chontae an Chabháin, Cruthaitheacht an Chabháin 2018–2022, an Plean Cultúir agus Cruthaitheachta maidir le hÉire Ildánach i gContae an Chabháin, a chur i láthair. Tá de dhea-theist ar an gcontae seo le fada go ndéantar infheistíocht sa chultúr agus sa chruthaitheachta trí chur chuige na páirtnéireachta mar atá á chothú ag an meitheal cultúir i ndáil le tionsnaimh áitiúla, réigiúnacha agus náisiúnta le cuid mhaithe blianta anuas. Is féidir dea-thortháí dáiríre a thabhairt i gcrích trí oibriú in éineacht le muintir an chontae agus ar mhaith leo agus sin a dhéanamh tríd an gcaidreamh agus tríd an gcomhar; sin modh oibre a thaitníonn linne agus a gclóitear leis.

The Cavan Note – Cultúr agus Cruthaitheacht Chontae an Chabháin

3 The Cavan Note – Culture and Creativity in Cavan

Contae an Chabháin an contae ina bhfuil foinse dhá abhair; dhá uiscebealach a bhfuil macalla chomh mór leo i meon an Éireannaigh agus atá le haon réimse talún a bhí ag treibh ar bith de chuid na hÉireann riamh – an Éirne agus an tSionainn.

TÁ CONTAE AN CHABHÁIN i gCúige Uladh agus é ar cheann de shé cinn de chontaetha a shíneann leis an teorainn. Droimlíní agus réimsí uisce na tréithe tireolaíochta is suntasaí atá ag rith leis. Tá an Contae agus baile an chontae ar an aon ainm amháin, An Cabhán, a chiallaíonn ‘logán’ nó a mhalaírt sin chomh maith, ‘cnocán cruinn tirim’. Tá ceangal idir réimse chontae an lae inniu agus barúntacht Bhréifne Thoir agus is minic a bhaintear úsáid as tagairt do sheantreibh Bhréifne i ndáil leis an gcontae.

Tá iarsmaí breátha ar fáil sa chontae i gcoináí ó na tréimhsí lonnáiochta éagsúla a d’fhág a lorg ar thaobh tire an chontae anuas go dtí an lá atá inniu ann. Taobh tire iarmharach a thugtar ar áit de leithéid Pháirc Bhoirinn an Chabháin, in aice leis an mBlaic, leis na séadchomharthaí adhlactha, na hionaid cónaí agus lorg na ngarraithe ó ré na réamhstaire. Tá carraigí móra corra le fáil ón oighhear-ré dheireanach agus is fianaise an gleann triomaithe agus na doilínte a ghabhann leis ar abhair a bheith anseo roimh aimsir na n-oighearshruthanna agus ar shlogaide ó shin. Baineann an t-ábhar iontaise in aolchloch an cheantair le coiréal a bhí i bhfarrage thrópaiceach 350 milliún bliain ó shin.

Tá lorg thionchar na Normannach sa dara céad déag le feiceáil sa chontae. Tá sampla maith dá leithéid sin ar fáil i gCloch Locha Uachtair agus tá lorg ré na mainistreach le feiceáil go fóill in Oileán na Trónóide agus i Mainistir Mhuire. Plandál Uladh ba chionsíocair le bailte

Rita Kelly, profile of County Cavan, Arts Plan 2004 to 2009

COUNTY CAVAN IS in the province of Ulster and is one of six border counties. It is characterised by drumlins and waterways. The county shares its name with the county town, An Cabhán, which in Irish means ‘the hollow’ and also has the opposite meaning, ‘a round dry hill’. The county today owes its origins to the barony of East Breifne and is often referred to as the Breifne County.

The county retains fine examples of the various settlement periods that helped shape the landscape of Cavan today. Cavan Burren Park, near Blacklion, is referred to as a ‘relic’ landscape with funereal monuments, habitation sites and field patterns that date from prehistoric times. Large glacial erratics found there date from the last Ice Age and its dry valley and associated dolines bear testimony to a pre-glacial river and sink. The fossils embedded in its limestone are the coral of a tropical sea of 350 million years ago.

The county retains a Norman influence from the twelfth century. Clough Oughter Castle is an example of this and a monastic influence is still evident at Trinity Island and St Mary’s Abbey, Cavan. The Plantation of Ulster gave rise to the towns of Bailieborough, Cootehill, Kingscourt, and Virginia.

Culturally, the county is rich in literary history with the Sheridans from Quilca near Mullagh the pre-eminent family of note. Thomas Sheridan (1687–1738) was a great friend of Dean Jonathan Swift and both men were noted figures in the Dublin cultural scene. Swift spent many

móra Choill an Chollaigh (Bailieborough), Muinchille (Cootehill), Dún an Rí (Kingscourt) agus Achadh an Iúir (Virginia) a theacht chun cinn le héagsúlacht shuntasach ó thaobh a gcuid ainmeacha.

Tá cuid mhór staire ag baint leis an geontaí maidir le cursaí litríochta agus is iad muintir Shioradáin as Cuilceach i ngar don Mhullach an teaghlaich is iomráití. Ba chara mór Tomás Ó Sioradáin (1687–1738) ag an Déan Jonathan Swift agus an bheirt acu go mór chun cinn i saol an chultúir i mBaile Átha Cliath lena linn. Is iomaí samhradh a chaith Swift i gCuilceach agus is ann a scríobhadh an chuid is mó de Gulliver’s Travels. Ba é William Bedell, Anglacánach a rugadh i Sasana agus a bhí ina Easpag na Cille Móire idir 1629 agus 1642 a choimisiúnaigh aistriú an Bhíobla go Gaeilge. Cheap sé daoine a raibh Gaeilge acu sa chléir i bparóstí an deoise chomh mór agus ab fhéidir leis.

Ba scríbhneoir cáiliúil agus bainisteoir amharclainne Tomás Ó Sioradáin (1719–1788), mac an Tomáis eile, agus bhí baint aige ar feadh tréimhse fada le hamharclann Smock Alley. Fear aoir, drámaíochta agus filíochta ab ea a mhacsan, Richard Brinsley (1751–1816), a bhí ina úinéir ar feadh i bhfad ar amharclann an London Theatre Royal i Drury Lane. Ba as an Mullach freisin Henry agus Charlotte Brooke, athair agus iníon, an t-athair a scríobh *Fool of Quality*, tráchtas ar chúrsaí oideachais i gcló úrsceíl agus an iníon a tharraing cál uirthi féin maidir le scoláireacht na Gaeilge nuair a d’fhoilsigh sí *Reliques of Irish Poetry*.

Mary Anne Sadlier (1820–1903) an t-údar mná is cáiliúla as Contae an Chabháin. D’fhoilsigh sise seasca úrsceíl agus scríobh sí do phobal na n-imirceach as Éirinn sna Stáit Aontaithe. Is é an file de chuid an ochtú haois déag is mó a bhfuil cál air as an gCabhán, Cathal Buí Mac Giolla Ghunna as barúntacht

summers in Quilca and it was here that most of ‘Gulliver’s Travels’ was written. The noted English-born Anglican churchman William Bedell who served as Bishop of Kilmore from 1629 to 1642 commissioned the translation of the Bible into the Irish language and appointed Irish speaking clergy to parishes as often as possible.

Thomas Sheridan, Junior (1719–1788) was a noted writer and theatrical manager and had a long association with Smock Alley theatre. His son Richard Brinsley (1751–1816) was a satirist, playwright and poet, and a long-time owner of the London Theatre Royal in Drury Lane. The father and daughter Henry and Charlotte Brooke also came from Mullagh and Brooke, Senior wrote the novel ‘Fool of Quality’ which is a treatise on education under the guise of fiction, and Charlotte made her reputation as an Irish scholar with the publication of ‘Reliques of Irish Poetry’.

Mary Anne Sadlier (1820–1903), is Cavan’s best known female author who published sixty novels and wrote for Irish emigrants in the United States. The most notable 18th century Cavan poet was Cathal Buidhe Mac Giolla Ghunna from Tullyhaw barony, who composed ‘An Bunnán Buidhe’, while in the 19th century Philip O’Connell from Mountnugent found fame for the tale of ‘Orwin and Sebena’. Percy French and Padraig Colum are noted writers who spent time in Cavan and were influenced by the landscape and culture of the county.

Cavan poets, teachers and literary figures played a significant role in the period prior to and during the 1916 Rising, with Agnes O’Farrelly and Francis Sheehy Skeffington also prominent in this regard. Agnes O’Farrelly originated in Raffony near Mullagh and was a leading academic and professor of Irish at University College Dublin. She became a leading member of the Gaelic League and presided at the

Theallach Eathach a rinne an t-amhrán ‘An Bonnán Buí’. Bhí cáil sa naoú haois déag ar Philip O’Connell as Mountnugent mar gheall ar an scéal ‘Orwin and Sebena’. Scríbhneoir iomráiteacha iad Percy French agus Padraic Colum a chaith tréimhsí ama sa Chabhán agus a ndeacaigh an taobh tire agus cultúr an chontae i gcionn orthu.

Bhí filí, muínteoirí agus daoine eile den lucht litríochta as contae an Chabháin go mór chun cinn i rith an tréimhse anuas go dtí Éirí Amach 1916 agus lena linn agus bhí Úna Ní Fhaircheallaigh agus Francis Sheehy Skeffington go mór i gceist ina leith sin. I Rafanaigh in aice leis an Mullach a rugadh Úna Ní Fhaircheallaigh a raibh cáil uirthi i measc an lucht léinn agus í ina hollamh le Gaeilge i gColáiste na hOllscoile, Baile Átha Cliath. Bhí sí mór le rá i gConradh na Gaeilge agus is í a bhí i gceannas ar an gcéad chruinniú de Chumann na mBan. I gCoill an Chollaigh a rugadh an scríbhneoir agus an feachtasóir radacach Francis Sheehy Skeffington a mharraigh Arm na Breataine ar Chéadaoin Sheachtain na Cásca.

Tá Tom MacIntyre ar an scríbhneoir is iomráiti de chuid an Chabháin ó ré sin na réabhlóidiochta i leith. Ba chuimhin leisean, tráth a raibh sé ag labhairt le leanai bunscoile sa cheantar faoin méid scríbhneoirí a bhain leis an gcontae, go raibh buachaill amháin a dúirt “All the lakes are haunted”.

inaugural meeting of Cumann na mBan. Writer and radical activist Francis Sheehy Skeffington was born in Bailieborough and was killed by the British Army on the Wednesday of Easter week.

Most notable among Cavan’s modern-day writers is Tom MacIntyre who, when talking to local national school children about the proliferation of writers in the county, recalled that one boy said “All the lakes are haunted”.

“He’s right—the child’s right! He knew! All the lakes are haunted. That’s the Cavan note in my writing. It’s the Cavan note in Harding’s writing; it’s the Cavan note in Healy’s writing. It’s haunted territory and that’s recognised,” said MacIntyre.

Tá Noel Monahan, Heather Brett agus Dave Rudden ar scribhneoirí na linne seo a chuireann ina gcuid próis agus ina gcuid filíochta le cultúr an Chabháin. Tá Noel agus Heather ina n-eagarthóirí le Windows Publications agus iad ag cur leis an bhforbairt ar an litríocht do leanai agus do dhaoine óga le 25 bliain anuas. Tá Noel an-dearbach maidir le hÉire Ildánach agus é den tuairim go ndéanann an clár:

Noel Monahan, Heather Brett and Dave Rudden are among the current generation of Cavan writers who define our culture in poetry and prose. Noel and Heather are editors of Windows Publications and for 25 years they have contributed to the development of literature for children and young people. Noel is very positive about Creative Ireland and feels it:

‘Allows us time to reflect
on what it means to be human
Time to reflect on our lives
To connect with our feelings
To allow us time to adjust to
the ever changing conditions in our lives
To ease our letting go of the past
To jolt all our dreams to a new awakening
To awaken from an all too
Catholic mindset of the past
It allows us feel at home in a
New Ireland of our making’.

Deir Heather Brett ina leith: “As a writer and artist the creative programme has given rise to a feeling of solidarity among the arts... we are a talented nation where we have already made it clear that culture is vital to our existence and necessary for our growth as a people and as community. The opportunities this programme has provided are an asset to going forward and realising our potential as artists and enhancing the cultural worth of a people. The programme gives a basis to all of us to know that we are valued as artists and writers and are an integral part of Irish life”.

Shane Connaughton is an award-winning screenwriter, having worked on '*My Left Foot*', and a number of his works have been adapted for the cinema. '*The Playboys*' and '*The Run of The Country*' were filmed in the vicinity of Redhills Village. He is also an acclaimed novelist and his recent book '*Married Quarters*' was hailed as "a glorious late flowering" by the Irish Times. The county is proud to share the legacy of the late Dermot Healy, whose work includes '*The Bend for Home*', an homage to a town and the people who inhabit it at a moment in time.

Traditional music in the county received a massive injection of interest with three consecutive years of Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann in the county town from 2010 to 2012. The largest festival of traditional music in the world was made possible by Comhaltas Ceoltóirí na hÉireann and the work of the NYAH festival, with the support of the local authority.

The number of young people in the county aware of and participating in traditional arts has increased as a result of the Fleadh and the cultural sector acted quickly to maximise the potential of this renowned festival. Visual arts and theatre practitioners particularly engaged with the festival and used the town as a canvas for site-specific art that was multi-disciplinary and immersive in experience. These groups included the Gonzo Theatre, The Hacklers, trans-art, Rianta art, the Traveller Community and Mórtas an Chabháin.

The new communities who have settled in the County bring their unique cultural experiences to our county and they meld this with their Cavan experience to create new work reflecting different realities; notable among them are the animators, Konik Studios.

Collaboration, particularly between the visual arts and the spoken word, is the hallmark of many Cavan artists and defines the practice of Yvonne Cullinan, Tom Conaty and Jane McCormick. The Public Art Project 'The Current' is an example of this collaboration.

Cavan County Council with the support of the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht under the Arts and Culture Capital Scheme and the Peace IV Programme has committed to a significant investment at Townhall Cavan to provide a quality venue for artist-led activity in the county, housed in this building designed by William Scott in 1906.

Ramor Theatre, Virginia opened in 1999 and its programme includes local and touring theatre, music, comedy and film club nights. It is the home of Livin' Dred Theatre Company, founded by Padraic McIntrye, director, and Aaron Monaghan, actor, with a view to producing classical Irish theatre and new writing for local and national audiences.

They follow a strong tradition of theatre practitioners in the county including TP McKenna, the actor from Mullagh who had a long and distinguished career on stage and film in Ireland and in Britain.

The Cavan-born actress Derbhlé Crotty is best known for her work with the Abbey Theatre, the Royal Shakespeare Company, and Druid. Amateur drama is strong in the county with local groups The Hacklers, Bailieborough Drama Group and Millrace Players Mullagh all winning All-Ireland Drama titles, with neighbouring Carrigallen Theatre also winning with 'The Devil's Céili', written by Cavan writers Philip Doherty and Kevin McGahern.

The Cavan, Shercock, Maudabawn and Mullagh Drama Festivals offer valuable opportunities for drama groups throughout Ireland to show work and receive valuable

feedback from adjudicators with experience in professional theatre. Cavan Drama Festival was established in 1945 and has a well-established reputation nationally.

Lisa O'Neill, Áine Cahill, and The Strypes are among the new generation of musical talent from the county who have a distinctive Cavan voice, bringing Cavan accents and attitude to a world stage and inspiring budding creatives at home. The Would Be's who were championed by the legendary John Peel in the 1990s have also reformed and released a new single 'Tempt Fate' in July 2017. Important in the history of community music in the county is the Marching Band tradition, notably in Kingscourt, Bunnoe and Mullaghboy, while the Bailieborough School of Music has played an important role in shaping the musical experiences and careers of many young people.

Cavan-born composer Tom Cullinan has an extensive collaboration with theatre particularly Galway's An Taibhdhearc and Druid Theatre and has a comprehensive catalogue of chamber music and solo instrument compositions. Ed Reavy, the composer and fiddle player from Barnagrove, near Cootehill, is regarded as one of the finest and most prolific composers of Irish Dance tunes with 500 compositions to his name. Contemporary composer Paul Flynn has received international recognition and he is particularly noted for ecclesiastical music.

Cavan County Library service is acknowledged as having one of the foremost collections of local studies material in the country with particular reference to literary and cultural material and this is fully exploited by local researchers. The library service gives particular focus to working with local reading groups and there is an extensive programme for schools' engagement annually.

The Irish language has an important focus in the library events programme. There is a particular emphasis on Seachtain na Gaeilge each March, and the Irish language is fite fuáite trí (interwoven) throughout library programming (Culture Night, Bealtaine and Children's events). The library provides a wide and varied programme of events throughout the year mar shampla Club na nÓg, Club Leabhar and Ciorcal Comhra (which takes place in a number of branch libraries). Cavan County Museum is a flagship cultural building for the county, housing an impressive collection of artefacts of cultural and historical interest including some of national significance. It is a nationally designated museum and has achieved recognition for its work in the area of peace-building most recently with the General Post Office replica recreation from 1916 and the First World War Trench Experience.

The cultural sector in County Cavan has long valued collaboration as the norm, ensuring that creativity is nurtured and available to all citizens.

The history of culture and creativity is long and varied and laid the foundations of today's vibrant artistic landscape, where Cavan artists have enjoyed international success on an unprecedented scale and participation in the arts at all levels is high. Creative Ireland will provide a platform to ensure that this trend continues and the creativity of this small border county will continue to resonate around the globe.

Collaboration

Creative Cavan and collaboration are inextricably linked. Collaboration is key to the success of this Strategy. The origins of Creative Cavan collaborations to date, are among people who have thought outside of their normal sphere of work and life, looking to link with other departments, agencies, companies, organisations and individuals, daring to try something different or take a new approach. These partnerships have initially developed informally, connecting organisations not previously or sufficiently connected. People and organisations from different backgrounds and disciplines have shared knowledge and resources. Some of these connections have now been formalised as a result of this positivity.

The key drivers for success in any venture is genuine collaboration, as was evidenced in the successful 2016 centenary programme where government agencies, cultural,

Ba léir an tábhacht atá ag muintir na hÉireann leis an gcultúr agus leis an gcruthaitheacht ón lón mór daoine a tháinig i láthair agus ón spéis a léirigh siad sna ceardlanna pobail áitiúla chun plé a dhéanamh ar an ábhar agus ar an tábhacht atá leis sa chontae. Tugadh sainmhíniú agus scrúdú den chineál is forleithne ar chultúr agus ar chruthaitheacht agus is iomaí tuairim a cuireadh chun tosaigh faoi ghnéithe a bhféadfaí thírí orthu. Bhí coincheap an chomhair le sonrú i gcontae an Chabháin idir 2010 – 2012 nuair a d'éirigh thar cionn le Fleadhanna a cuireadh ar siúl i mbaile an chontae agus meitheal eagrúcháin faoi cheannródaíocht an údarás áitiúil i bhfeighil ar lón 750,000 duine de lucht an cheoil a tharraingt go dtí an contae ag an am. Rinne na brainsí cultúir éagsúla i gComhairle Chontae an Chabháin comhoibriú riamh ar thionscadail a thiocfadh faoi scáth níos mó ná aon bhrainse amháin acu agus neartóidh Éire Ildánach a theacht chun cinn leis an ngnás sin. Beidh Cruthaitheacht an Chabháin ina spreagadh maidir le comhoibriú ar gach leibhéal idir daoine aonair, eagraíochtaí agus gníomhaireachtaí agus comhlacthaí reachtúla. Beidh fiúntas faoi leith le páirtnéireachta de chineálacha nua a chruthú agus leas i gcónaí as an gcomhar atá ar bun cheana féin a chothú arís.

educational institutions, community groups and organisations, artists and individuals came together to deliver a successful national programme. The value of culture and creativity to Irish society was highlighted by the tremendous turnout and engagement by the public in the local community workshops to discuss the topic and its importance in the county. Culture and creativity were defined and examined in the broadest manner with many suggestions as to what should be focused on. This concept of collaboration was reflected in Cavan from 2010 – 2012 when three successful Fleadhanna were held in the county town and the local authority led team oversaw an influx of 750,000 music fans to the county over the period. The component cultural sections in Cavan County Council have always cooperated on mutually beneficial projects and the advent of Creative Ireland will continue this tradition. Creative Cavan will encourage collaboration at all levels between individuals, organisations agencies and statutory bodies. New collaborations will be of particular value while existing partnerships will be nurtured.

Is contae leis an teorainn atá i gContae an Chabháin ach is iomaí ceantar sa chontae ar féidir turas chun oibre a dhéanamh astu go Baile Átha Cliath. Rangaítear dó dhéag faoin gcéad den daonra mar dhaoine ón iasach agus baineann cùig déag faoin gcéad le creidimh mionlaigh nó tá siad gan creideamh ar bith. Is contae codarsnachta Contae an Chabháin. Fágann leathnú suntasach ar an daonra i ndeisceart an chontae, atá i bhfoisceacht turas chun oibre de Bhaile Átha Cliath, gur tharla breis imirce isteach sa chontae ó chontaetha eile leis an gcósta thoir agus is mór an chodarsnacht idir sin agus ceantair in iarthar an Chabháin ar beag dlúis atá leis an daonra iontu. Táthar tugtha, maidir leis an gclár Éire Ildánach, do dheisceanna a chruthú do pháirt a bheith ag dreamanna mionlaigh agus ag dreamanna mórlaigh le chéile in imeachtaí cultúir agus cruthaitheachta ionas go dtarlaíonn malartú agus babhtáil cultúir ar leibhéal ard agus go gcuirtear córais nua cruthaitheachta ar bun.

Inclusivity

Creative Cavan is for all our citizens. No-one will be excluded for social, geographic or economic reasons. As programme producers, we must be inclusive of all needs and opinions. Creative Cavan acknowledges the varied and ever changing population profile of Cavan and recognises existing and newer minority groups, cultures, religions and nationalities. A border county, many parts are in commutable distance of Dublin City. Twelve per cent of the population is categorised as foreign national, and fifteen percent belongs to minority or no religions. Cavan is a county of contrasts. Significant population expansion in the south of the county which forms part of the commuter belt to Dublin has seen increased immigration into the county from other East coast counties, contrasting with very sparsely populated areas of West Cavan. Creative Ireland is committed to actively making opportunities for joint involvement of majority and minority communities resulting in rich culture exchanges and making new creative networks.

Cumarsáid

Beidh foclóocht shoiléir in úsáid maidir le Cruthaitheacht an Chabháin, agus taobhófar le Béarla den Ghnáthchineál. Communication

Creative Cavan will use clear, inclusive language, subscribing to Plain English. This will ensure that messages will be clearly communicated and easy to understand. Language will be friendly, encouraging and un-ambiguous with the aim of involving all citizens. The programme will be communicated through all available channels and will be delivered imaginatively, visually, orally and through new media, to support maximum participation.

Empowerment

It is important that all citizens and groups throughout the county have access to the resources and skills to engage with Creative Cavan. The Culture Team will foster and encourage the maximum connectivity to ensure that all resources are focused in a manner to give all citizens opportunities to engage with and inform the creative process in all its forms.

Pobal

Tuigtear go maith don Mheitheal Cultúir an tábhacht atá le nasc a cheangal leis an gcruthaitheacht ar fud an phobail agus lena spreagadh agus beifear ag áitiú ar phobal bisiúil na n-ealaíon sa chontae faoi láthair brostú in athuair leis an mborradh a tháinig le roint blianta anuas. Is gnéithe mórhábhachtaча de sin an caidreamh agus an pháirtneireacht. Oibreoidh na brainsí uile san údarás áitiúil a bhaineann le hábhar, iad siúd a obríonn maidir leis an bPáirtneireacht Spóirt, le hIlchuimsitheacht Shóisialta, leis an lucht siúil, agus ar an gclár Ceart Léitheoreachta, d'fhoill a chinntíú go mbíonn an clár Éire Ildánach ilchuimsitheach.

Fiontraíocht

Déanfar an fiontraíocht, sa chiall is leithne ó thaobh na cruthaitheachta, a chothú agus a spreagadh an t-am go léir. Beidh tréithe maidir le dul i bhfiontar, seiftíúlacht, díocas pearsanta agus dúthracht an phobail de dhíth chun Cruthaitheacht an Chabháin a thabhairt i bhfeidhm go sásúil. Cuireann meon na fiontraíochta go mór le tréithe inmharthanacha agus neamhspleáchais na hoibre i ndáil le Cruthaitheacht an Chabháin.

Community

The Culture Team recognises the importance of linking with and encouraging creativity throughout the community and the existing vibrant arts community in the county will be encouraged to build on the momentum gained in recent years. Dialogue and partnership are key to this. All relevant sections in the local authority including those working in Sports Partnership, Social Inclusion, with the travelling community, and on the Right to Read programme will be engaged to ensure that the Creative Ireland programme is comprehensive and inclusive.

The ideals of Right to Read are particularly important because all children are creative when young but if they lack the basic literacy and numeracy skills their ability to be creative in later life is adversely affected. The Culture Team is aware of the importance of linking with school programming as a fundamental necessity in the creative process.

Entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurship in the widest possible creative sense will be nurtured and encouraged at all times. Qualities of risk-taking, resourcefulness, personal and community drive and enthusiasm will be required for successful delivery of Creative Cavan. Entrepreneurship as a value significantly contributes to the sustainability and self-sufficiency of the work of Creative Cavan.

Beidh an teacht céanna ag gach saoránach ar Chruthaitheacht an Chabháin agus coinneoidh an Mheitheal Cultúir caidreamh ar bun leis na gníomhairí feidhmiúcháin maidir leis an gclár a thabhairt i gcrích ionas nach ndéantar gné ar bith a shéanadh ar aon duine mar gheall ar chuíseanna cultúir, fisiciúla, sóisialta nó eacnamaíochta.

Openness and Transparency

The mode of delivery by the Culture Team will be clear and principled. They will act with integrity, demanding that all collaborations are genuine and clear. The team will operate with an open-mindedness that will always be ready to encourage, explore and create new connections, collaborations and partnerships at every conceivable level. Annual plans, reviews and invitations for submissions will be presented clearly and accountably.

Participation

The Cavan Culture Team will make every effort to ensure maximum participation. Respectful engagement of individuals, groups and organisations will be sought. This engagement will range from attending events to actively taking part in events. All citizens will have equality of access to Creative Cavan, and the Culture Team will liaise with those programme delivery agents, to ensure that no-one is excluded for cultural, physical, social or economic reasons.

Réimse Príomhthábhachta 1: Scéal na hÁite – Scéal na nDaoine

Le Scéal na hÁite – Scéal na nDaoine, beidh mórtas cine, féiniúlacht agus ceangal leis an áit le brath ag muintir an Chabháin. Tá cuid mhór staire agus cultúir ag rith le contae an Chabháin. Bionn síorathrú ar an gceangal a bhraitear leis an áit, síordhul chun cinn de réir mar a bhímid fein ag teacht chun cinn mar phobal iolraíoch, síorléiriú ar an athrú atá fúinn agus ar mheon sóisialta an phobail. Ligeann na bearta ealaíne agus cultúir is seasta fadmharthaná don phobal túisceana a fháil ar an gcomhthéacs staire, cultúir, eacnamaíochta agus sóisialta atá ag gabháil leo mar dhaoine – bunús riachtanach le mórtas áite.

Is fada caidreamh ó thaobh cúrsaí cultúir ag Meitheal Cultúir an Chabháin agus ag muintir na háite le láithreacha agus le háiseanna cathartha de leithéid Chaisleán Shandarsan, Páirc Bhoirinn an Chabháin, Bealaí an Óir agus seoda ailtireachta an chontae. Tá oiread suntais leis an gcontae ó thaobh cúrsaí geolaíochta agus éiceolaíochta go bhfuil rátáil UNESCO ina leith maidir le tábhacht dhomhanda.

Is iomaí codarsnacht i gceist le contae an Chabháin. Is mór idir bailte móra ina gcónaíonn daoine a oibríonn i mBaile Átha Cliath agus ceantair iargúlta tuaithe nach bhfuil na córais tacaíochta agus na deiseanna céanna ar fáil iontu atá ar fáil i gceantair eile ar fud na tíre. Tá toradh Ré na dTrioblóidí le sonrú go föill i gContae an Chabháin ó thaobh cúrsaí socheacnamaíochta, cultúr agus infreastreachtúir. Ní heol go föill a mbeidh i ndán le Breatimeacht, más ábhar dúshláin nó deise a thagann dá bharr don chontae. Tugtar deis leis an réimse príomhthábhachta seo cíoradh agus daingniú a dhéanamh ar an mórtas cine, ar an mórtas áite agus an smaointeoirreacht chruthaitheachta, na scileanna fiontraíochta agus an chuimhne cultúr a chothú agus a thabhairt chun cinn.

Priority 1: The Story of Place – The Story of Us

The Story of Place – The Story of Us will provide a sense of place, identity and belonging to our people. Cavan is a county that is historically rich and culturally vibrant. Our sense of place is constantly evolving and progressing as we develop as a pluralist society, reflecting on our evolution and our developing social values within our community. The most enduring artistic and cultural interventions allow a community to begin to understand its' own historic, cultural, economic, and social context – an essential foundation for creating a sense of place.

Cavan Culture Team and local communities have a long history of cultural engagement with place and civic amenities such as Castle Saunderson, Cavan Burren Park, the Golden Ways and architectural wealth of the county. The county is geologically and ecologically significant by global standards as acknowledged in the UNESCO rating.

Cavan is a county of contrasts. Towns in the Dublin commuter belt contrast with isolated rural areas, which lack supports and opportunities available nationally in other areas. County Cavan retains a legacy from The Troubles; soci-economically, culturally and infrastructurally. Brexit is an unknown, potentially offering challenges or opportunities to impact positively on the county. This priority provides an opportunity to explore and reinforce our sense of identity, pride of place and to develop creative thinking, entrepreneurial skills and cultural memory.

Sin a d'fhág gur cruthaíodh deis le Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann idir na blianta 2010 agus 2012 leas sóisialta agus eacnamaíochta an chontae a dhéanamh le féile mhór na seanealaíon traidisiúnta ach cur chuige ar bhealach uilechuimsitheach lenar ghabh meon deis don uile dhuine, bearta tionscantacha glasa, clár imeachtaí comhaimseartha, aird agus tuiscint ar chúrsaí cultúir a chothú agus gach cuid den chontae a thabhairt i gceist go beo bríomhar. Is maith an teist an forás atá faoi Oíche an Chultúir (ó thaobh lucht féachana agus éisteachta agus lucht eagraithe ar aon) ar an bhfonn atá ar an bpobal agus ar lucht an chultúir saothar a chruthú agus a chur i láthair. Ar an gcuma chéanna, mar gheall ar chur chuige nua maidir le cúrsáí eolaíochta, déantar cruthaitheacht agus nuáil a spreagadh le Féile Eolaíochta an Chabháin agus Mhuineacháin i gcomhar le Bord Oideachais agus Oiliúna an Chabháin agus Mhuineacháin, Comhairle Chontae Mhuineacháin agus Fondúireacht Eolaíochta Éireann.

Priority 2:

Cavan – A Place to Thrive

Through involvement in arts and cultural activities the people of Cavan have greater opportunity to participate and make decisions that empower them to live inspired, diverse and healthy lives. The cultural offer available in the county will continue to make this an attractive place to work and reside in.

In Cavan there is a strong and diverse cultural sector. Our strength is our people and their ability to adapt, to problem solve and to envision. The curiosity and resilience of Cavan people is a great strength to our cultural sector. This made Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann 2010 to 2012 an opportunity for a major traditional arts festival to lead social and economic benefit for the county through a holistic approach that involved an access for all agenda, green initiatives, contemporary arts programming, cultural awareness and a whole-county dynamic approach. The growth of Culture Night (both audience and host involvement) exemplifies the strong desire for community and cultural practitioners to make and present their work. Similarly, our collaborative Cavan Monaghan Science Festival inspires creativity and innovation through novel approaches to science, in collaboration with Cavan Monaghan ETB, Monaghan County Council and Science Foundation Ireland.

Our approach to the 1916 Commemorations exemplified a sense of local empowerment. The living talent in County Cavan communities and cultural practitioners pursued exciting and innovative ways for involvement in remembrance through cultural programming. This programme told our 1916 story honestly and sensitively. The programme did not shy away from raising and facing contentious issues, and was cognisant of the mixed traditions of our

Cavan County Council Culture Team works with national and international practitioners to ensure that work remains relevant. 'Developing Creative Practice Across Borders' the arts office and social inclusion led initiative, is an example of this type of project with six international partners providing quality arts experience for Irish artists through exchange.

Supporting local artists and creative practitioners to live and work in Cavan is essential. Equally important is support to enable these practitioners to leverage funds from external sources. The Creative Ireland support for Kingscourt artist Alan James Burns encouraged this artist to work with Fermanagh and Omagh District Council, Marble Arch Caves Global Geopark, and succeed in fund raising from Central Government through the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht. The possibility of delivering a flag ship county wide festival that caters for a range of cultural offerings will be explored during the lifetime of the strategy.

Research will be carried out to identify the investment needs of the cultural sector and it is envisaged that funding will be sought from National and European sources to improve the infrastructural and technical resources of the county.

Priority 2: Cavan – A Place to Thrive

1. Support local communities to improve their cultural programme and reward those who aim toward innovation and collaboration with a dedicated cultural fund
2. Provide training for cultural promoters including community activists to lead and manage cultural provision and all elements of events management.
