Foreword R É A M H R Á

It is with great pride that we write this introduction to the first Culture and Creativity Plan for County Louth, and we invite all citizens of Louth, and visitors to our county, to participate in the events detailed within this innovative document.

We often take for granted those things which come easily to us. As individuals, we tend to downplay talents which we possess, and which require little practice and less work. However, it is these naturally-occurring skills and abilities which can seem the most impressive to others. Ireland has long been recognised as a nation to which creativity and cultural achievement come easily and naturally. Words are our currency, and music is a publically-owned utility. The arts and heritage in Ireland are a more socially-engaged initiative than in other countries, and culture as a whole is far more of a co-operative society than a private enterprise. Long may this continue, and long may it continue in Louth.

This is a unique place. Rivers, drumlins, mountains and coastline encircle both rich agricultural land and the two largest towns in Ireland. Louth bridges Ulster and Leinster, industry and farming, the Pale and Gaelic Ireland. Most of Ireland's national Iron Age epic, An Táin Bó Cuailgne, takes place in Louth, and our language retained an unbroken line here until the death of Anna Uí Annlúain from Omeath in 1969. The area around Omeath was the last Irish-speaking area in Leinster, and in the early part of the 20th century, it attracted thousands of Irish speakers and learners, including Douglas Hyde, Eoin Mac Néill and Pádraig Pearse, who travelled to Louth to hear the rich canúint of the area. This last outpost of Irish hints at the strength and vitality of Oriel, the region of south east Ulster and northeast Leinster, which at one period in the eighteenth century was the most important centre for the creation of poetry and literature on the island of Ireland. In recent years, this partly-forgotten heritage has been rescued, reclaimed, and re-presented by

Tá na healaíona agus an oidhreacht in Éirinn ina dtionscnamh ina bhfuil níos mó comhpháirtíochta sóisialta ná mar atá i dtíortha eile, agus is mó go mór de chomharchumann ná d'fhiontar atá sa chultúr ina iomláine. academics, singers and musicians, chief amongst whom is Pádraigín Ní Uallacháin, whose book, "A Hidden Ulster", brought the poems, songs and personalities of Oriel to a wider audience. The important collections of music and songs made by Luke Donnellan in the early years of the 20th century were the subject of a Masters dissertation by traditional musician, Gerry O'Connor, and many of these pieces of music have made their way back into the mainstream tradition through the playing of Gerry, Zoe Conway, Nuala Kennedy, Áine McGeeney and other musicians. In the south of the county, there exists an important song tradition, which has been handed down through local families, and has been collected and celebrated by musicians and academics such as Sean Corcoran. This Drogheda singing tradition is a living one, with many young people now singing the songs of the Usher and Carolan families.

Our past influences all our artforms. In Louth, we are blessed with an architectural and monastic heritage which gives witness to the tide of history in our county. This concrete existence is important from a tourism and economic point of view, but its real value is the way it ties us into our landscape and to our history in this small part of Ireland. Creativity is about how we use that which we inherit to produce new buildings, texts, music, and visual art which are relevant to contemporary life. Communities at ease with culture are strong communities, and strong communities are the bedrock of healthy societies. Cultural expression within communities is essential for communities to shape their own futures. Communities who sing, perform, act, write, and paint are better able to articulate their happiness, their dissatisfaction, their aspirations and their fears in a more effective and articulate way than those who for whom culture is not a realistic or relevant option. Culture and creativity are pathways to participation in civic dialogue.

The Creative Ireland Programme is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 - a five-year initiative, from 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. It is a high-level, high-ambition, all-of-government initiative to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation so that individually and collectively, in our personal lives and in our institutions, we can realise our full creative potential.

The Creative Ireland Programme is a culture-based programme designed to promote individual, community and national wellbeing. The core proposition is that participation in cultural activity drives personal and collective creativity, with significant implications for individual and societal wellbeing and achievement.

The Creative Ireland Programme is also the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in the Government's policy document, Culture 2025 - which states that arts and culture are intrinsic to the Irish State, acknowledges the need to increase access to, and participation in the arts, boost our creative industries, and preserve our heritage with a particular focus on language, landscape and the environment.

The programme is built around the themes of identity, culture and citizenship. The core operating principles are Collaboration and Communication, Community Empowerment, and Internationalisation.

Local authorities have a crucial role in the overall local delivery of the entire Creative Ireland programme and are exclusively mandated, through their culture teams, to deliver Pillar 2 of the programme - Enabling Creativity in Every Community. This devolution of responsibility for Creative Ireland to local authorities is inspired by the extraordinary impact of collaborative local authority co-ordinated projects for the centenary of 1916.

Amanda has the responsibility for the leadership, strategic planning, management and development of the library services for Louth County Council, including five branch libraries, a mobile and school library service.
