The Creative Ireland Programme

CLÁR ÉIRE ILDÁNACH

The Creative Ireland Programme is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 – a five-year initiative, from 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. It is a high-level, high-ambition, all government initiative to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation so that individually and collectively, in our personal lives and in our institutions, we can realise our full creative potential.

The Creative Ireland Programme is a culture-based programme designed to promote individual, community and national wellbeing. The core proposition is that participation in cultural activity drives personal and collective creativity, with significant implications for individual and societal wellbeing and achievement.

The Creative Ireland Programme is also the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in the Government's policy document, *Culture 2025 – Éire Ildánach*, which states that arts and culture are intrinsic to the Irish State, acknowledges the need to increase access to and participation in the arts, boost our creative industries, and preserve our heritage with a particular focus on language, landscape and the environment.

The programme is built around the themes of identity, culture and citizenship. The core operating principles are Collaboration and Communication, Community Empowerment, and Internationalisation.

Is éard is Clár Éire Ildánach ann Clár Oidhreachta an Rialtais le haghaidh Éire 2016. Tionscnamh cúig bliana is ea é, ó 2017 go 2022, a chuireann an chruthaitheacht ag croílár beartas poiblí. Tionscnamh ardleibhéil, ardmhianach uile-rialtais is ea é chun an chruthaitheacht a phróimhshruthú i saol mhuintir an náisiúin sa dóigh gur féidir linn ár lánacmhainneacht chruthaitheachta a fhíorú go hindibhidiúil agus le chéile, inár saol pearsanta agus inár n-institiúidí.

Clár cultúr bhunaithe atá i gClár Éire Ildánach atá ceaptha le leas agus folláine an duine, an phobail agus an náisiúin a chur chun cinn. Is é bunús an chláir go mbíonn rannpháirtíocht i ngníomhaíochtaí cultúir mar spreagthach don chruthaitheacht phearsanta agus don chomhchruthaitheacht, agus go bhfuil impleachtaí suntasacha leis sin i dtaca le leas agus folláine agus éachtaí an duine aonair agus na sochaí.

Is trí Chlár Éire Ildánach go príomha a chuirfear i bhfeidhm na tosaíochtaí atá i gcáipéis bheartais an Rialtais, *Cultúr 2025 – Éire Ildánach*. Deirtear ann go bhfuil na healaíona agus an cultúr ina ndlúthchuid de Stát na hÉireann. Aithnítear freisin an gá atá le rochtain ar na healaíona agus rannpháirtíocht iontu a mhéadú. De réir na cáipéise, ní mór na tionscail chruthaitheachta a threisiú agus ár n-oidhreacht a chaomhnú, agus béim ar leith a chur ar theanga, ar thórdhreach agus ar an gcomhshaol.

Is iad féiniúlacht, cultúr agus saoránacht na téamaí ar leith ar a bhfuil an clár bunaithe. Is iad Comhoibriú agus Cumarsáid, Cumasú an Phobail, agus Idirnáisiúnú na croíphrionsabail oibriúcháin.

Local authorities have a crucial role in the overall local delivery of the entire Creative Ireland Programme and are exclusively mandated, through their culture teams, to deliver Pillar 2 of the programme – *Enabling Creativity in Every Community*. This devolution of responsibility for the Creative Ireland Programme to local authorities is inspired by the extraordinary impact of collaborative local authority co-ordinated projects for the centenary of 1916.

This plan sets out the beginning of Sligo's part in this five-year journey, a truly important national policy initiative centred on culture and wellbeing.

Sligo County Council, in drafting our action plan, was very conscious of our role as coordinators of culture within the communities we serve. The action plan highlights some of the many events which Sligo County Council supports annually. Sligo is particularly well served by the cultural sector and this action plan is a mere sample of the level of creativity and culture to be found in County Sligo. Sligo has been to the fore in benefitting from the commitment of volunteers, in particular in the delivery of many cultural events throughout the County on an annual basis. Our action plan reflects Sligo's designation as European Volunteering Capital 2017.

Tá ról ríthábhachtach ag na húdaráis áitiúla i gcur i bhfeidhm clár iomlán Éire Ildánach. Tá mandáid acu, agus acusan amháin, tríd na meithleacha cultúir acu, Colún 2 den chlár a chur i bhfeidhm, mar atá Bonn a Chur faoin gCruthaitheacht i nGach Pobal. Bhí tionchar ollmhór ag na tionscadail chomhoibríocha a ndearna na rialtais áitiúla comhordú orthu le haghaidh Chomóradh 1916. Is mar gheall air sin a bhfuil an fhreagracht as Éire Ildánach á cur orthu anois.

Sa Phlean seo, leagtar amach na chéad chéimeanna i ról Shligigh san aistear cúig bliana. Aithnítear gur beartas náisiúnta fíorthábhachtach atá ann, é dírithe ar an gcultúr agus ar an leas agus folláine.

Agus ár bplean gnímh á dhréachtú againn, bhí aird Chomhairle Contae Shligigh go mór ar ár ról mar chomhordaitheoirí cultúir sna pobail a mbímid ag freastal orthu. Cuirtear béim sa phlean gnímh ar chuid de na himeachtaí a mbíonn Comhairle Contae Shligigh ag tacú leo ar bhonn bliantúil. Tá an earnáil chultúir i Sligeach láidir, agus níl sa phlean gnímh seo ach blaiseadh den leibhéal cruthaitheachta agus cultúir atá le fáil sa Chontae. Tá dúthracht na n-oibríthe deonacha i ndiaidh dul chun sochair go mór do Shligeach, go háirithe ó thaobh eagrú na n-imeachtaí cultúir uile a bhíonn ar siúl sa Chontae ó bhliain go bliain. Tá ainmniú Shligigh mar Phríomhchathair Oibre Deonaí na hEorpa, 2017 mar ghné lárnach dár bplean gnímh.
